ORDER

ORDERED that, pursuant to Section 520.11 of the Rules of the Court of Appeals and Section 602.2 of the Rules of the Appellate Division, First Department, the attorneys hereby admitted *pro hac vice* shall abide by the standards of professional conduct imposed upon members of the New York Bar, including the Rules of the Courts governing the conduct of attorneys and the Rules of Professional Conduct; and it is further

ORDERED that Anita Porte Robb, Gary C. Robb, and Thomas L. Stewart shall each be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of the State of New York with respect to any acts occurring during the course of their participation in this matter; and it is further

ORDERED that Anita Porte Robb, Gary C. Robb, and Thomas L. Stewart shall each notify the court immediately of any matter or event in this or any other jurisdiction which affects their standing as a member of the Bar.

This order is further conditioned upon all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with this Court being signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in this State and, more specifically, the firm of Schwartz, Ponterio and Levenson, PLLC, or any other firm of the State on New York which may be retained to succeed that firm, and that the said Matthew F. Schwartz, Esq, and/or any successor firm, shall be held responsible for said pleadings, briefs and other papers and for the conduct of the cause before the Court by the said Matthew F. Schwartz, Esq.
