

Supervisors,
Please advise your team members of a film crew operating in Redmond. Mr. Patrick Tarmey produces a made for YouTube bounty hunter and law enforcement themed shows. He is already recording in rural Deschutes County, but will soon begin filming inside Redmond.

His actors will be wearing black external vests with tan pants. They will have faux handguns on a duty belt, and their uniform may read "Franklin Police Department." His crew will also have a silver Chevy Tahoe with a light bar and covert red/blues. The film crew and actors will be filming "traffic stops" on side streets, primarily away from well-traveled streets. They will not be doing any pursuit scenes.

Mr. Tarmey has been asked to call into Dispatch with their location when filming (already doing this). RPD has additionally asked him to have his film crew wear OSHA-approved vests, and utilize A-frame signs to warn passers-by of filming. The City does not require any type of permit for this activity, only if they plan on closing a roadway.

Mr. Tarmey,

Sir, at this moment our previous agreement to allow you and your film crew to utilize red/blue emergency lights on public highways is rescinded. You are not allowed, under Oregon law (ORS 816.350), to utilize any form of red/blue emergency lights as part of your filming while on a public highway. Furthermore, your videos have caused significant concern at the Deschutes County Sheriff's Office and the Redmond Police Department. The Deschutes County Sheriff's Office has received complaints from the public of uniformed sheriff's deputies using physical force and the threat of deadly physical force in a public place, or in view of public place, because of your filming.

The Redmond Police Department regrets allowing you any permission to operate red/blue emergency lights on a public highway. As of this moment, you are to cease operation of red/blue lights emergency lights on public highways. You can and will be issued citations if this activity continues. You must seek a road closure through City of Redmond or Deschutes County permitting processes, for roads within the City of Redmond or outside of Redmond, but still within Deschutes County.

The Redmond Police Department, with assistance with the City of Redmond, will continue to research any additional requirements for a business license and insurance which may exist beyond criminal law. We encourage you to conduct your own research as well.

The Redmond Police Department and the Deschutes County Sheriff's Office take pride in keeping our communities safe. You are a welcome addition to our community as long as all laws are followed.

Narrative - Summary for report filed from [REDACTED]

Dear Redmond Police and Sheriff's office, It's come to the attention of many local residents that Patrick Thomas Tarmey (Youtube: Patty Mayo) and his staff are impersonating Sheriff's Officers on public roads in and around Redmond, Bend and Central Oregon. They've done filming at private residences and out on BLM, but now they are doing fake traffic stops in city limits on public roads as witnessed here. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=1W84fCNIQduI&t=160s> They are also driving their faux undercover police cars in full Sheriffs Uniforms on county roads as seen here. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=3Q-1mw2mH70&t=855s> They're claiming they are with "D.B.S.O" which is a department that doesn't exist anywhere in Oregon. They're often seen in these videos walking around with guns drawn which could be quite dangerous, for themselves and for the public. [https://www.dropbox.com/s/f4evi7bmq0qd7ep/License Plate.jpg?dl=0](https://www.dropbox.com/s/f4evi7bmq0qd7ep/License%20Plate.jpg?dl=0) Wearing a Sheriff's Officer uniform and driving an undercover police car in public is a criminal offense under 2017 ORS 162.367 "Criminal impersonation of a peace officer." Hopefully this should be enough information to further an investigation and make contact. If you have additional questions feel free to reach out.
